**To you we raise our hands up high,
and sing aloud your praise!**

The priest continues the prayer, recalling the words and actions of Jesus at the Last Supper.

Great is the mystery of faith:

at the conclusion of the prayer the priest says:

By whom, and with whom, and in whom, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all honour and glory be yours, almighty Father, for ever and ever. **Amen.**

All sit/kneel and silence may be kept.

The Communion

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; thy kingdom come; thy will be done; on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, the power and the glory, for ever and ever. **Amen**
